ARCHITECTS' AND ENGINEERS' SPECIFICATION

The area of rescue sign shall be TekTone[®] SI002 or approved equal. The sign shall be 6" high \times 12" wide and shall include the International Access Symbol in white on a contrasting blue background. The sign shall also include the text "AREA OF RESCUE ASSISTANCE" in 0.75" high white letters on the blue background and in Braille.

The area of rescue sign shall comply with ADA requirements.

FEATURES

The SI002 Area of Rescue Assistance Sign provides indication for area of rescue locations. It complies with ADA requirements and is intended to be used in conjunction with the TekTone® Tek-SAFE™ (NC150R) Area of Rescue Assistance System. These signs provide easy to understand indications of areas where people who require assistance in evacuating a building can go to await assistance.

- Meets ADA requirements (check local codes for additional requirements).
- 0.75" high letters and contrasting blue and white coloration for better visibility at distances.
- Includes "Area of Rescue Assistance" in Braille.
